CONTRACT AND CODE OF CONDUCT

PERFORMER'S RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Attending Rehearsals
- Memorizing Lines
- Dress Rehearsals
- Performances
- Helping with tear down and clean up at each show
- Providing your own transportation for practices and performances

EXPECTATIONS:

Responsible Behavior: Use of self-control in your actions and language. Be courteous to others through work and deed. Honor those around you by respecting them, encouraging them, and avoiding words or actions that would be harmful. This includes, but is not limited to, gossip, slander, profanity, etc.

Cooperation with Others: Listen and work together. When conflict arises it should be privately discussed immediately between the parties involved. If the matter is not resolved, the next stage is to meet directly with the director or assistant director. Please encourage one another to handle issues discreetly and immediately to avoid stumbling blocks for the performance.

Mutual Respect: Treat yourself, others, and property with care and consideration.

In the event of an emergency, I give consent for medical care and/or treatment

Self-Control: Maintain integrity inside and outside of rehearsals and shows. The directors of C.A.T.S. and/or The Colonial Center reserve the right to pull a cast member for behaviors that are not in line with standards of the facility, could cause harm/damage to the facility and/or others, and/or be a negative influence or poor reflection on the facility, directors, and/or associates. Anyone that is in possession of illegal substances of any kind, uses illegal substances of any kind, possesses a weapon of any kind, or engages in sexual and/or other inappropriate acts will be immediately barred from any further participation in or at The Colonial Center and will face any and all consequences by law. Law enforcement will immediately be summoned.

Personal Excellence: Put forth your best effort in whatever you attempt. You are positive representatives of C.A.T.S., The Colonial Center, your families, and community. In terms of performance this means demonstrating the following characteristics:

- DIRECTABILITY—The willingness to be directed, try new assignments, trust Director's decisions, and follow the rule. Exemplify an attitude that says, "I will do whatever it takes to be successful and grow as an artist."
- PASSION—A love of the arts and a desire to honor others with your talents and abilities. Put your heart and soul into what you do, knowing that it will be recognized.
- SELF-DISCIPLINE—Make a commitment to do your best regardless of circumstances or cost to yourself.
- INTEGRITY—Interact with others in honesty. Follow through on your word and do what is best for the group.
- HUMILITY—Judge yourself wisely. You are no better than anyone else. Accept that we all have strengths and weaknesses.
